Computer Basics Online

A new type of session is available from Monday September 5 th 2011, at Tow Law Community Centre for absolute beginners in Computing. The idea of these sessions will be enable people to become confident in the use of a computer, not only in the basic use of it but also exploring the Internet with skills such as e-mails, and online services such as shopping, using public services, job hunting and banking, plus digital photography. This is not a course as such but a steady progression through what interests the user, newcomers only access what they want to learn.

This is carried out using the **Go ON** website – www.go-on.co.uk – which offers free, easy-to-use email and web-search tools from a simple, banner-free website. It also includes basic IT courses – from how to use a key-board and mouse to keeping safe online, using government e-services, social networking and even online job-hunting.

Because it's for absolute beginners, it's also designed to be supported, so all of the first steps in computer and internet use will be supervised in our sessions. We will offer a positive experience so that users will want to keep on using it.

Drop-In sessions are available at Tow Law Community Centre open to any adults and it's **all for free**.
