# Tow Law celebrates World's Biggest Coffee Morning

On Friday September 24th, between 10.00 and 1.00 p.m., Tow Law Community Centre will hold a Coffee Morning as part of the Macmillan Cancer Charity's World's Biggest Coffee Morning.

The Tow Law Community Association is holding this as part of an information-giving session to highlight what is on offer at the Centre. As well as tea, coffee and biscuits, there will be members of staff on hand to answer any questions about the Programme at the Centre and there will be a raffle with prizes donated by local businesses as well as tombola, a cake stall and a sale of second hand books. Members of our IT Drop-In Group will be selling Christmas Cards that they have made (and excellent they are too!), the whole proceeds going to the Charity.

The World's Biggest Coffee Morning is one of the biggest fundraising events in the UK, with an estimated 2 million people raising their mugs for Macmillan last year.

This year's event takes place on Friday 24 September and with the public's help we aim to raise money towards a predicted total for the Charity of over £7 million for people affected by cancer. Every year 270,000 people are diagnosed with cancer in the UK. We want to support every one of those people and their friends and families too. We can only do this with the public's help and we are hoping the public of Tow Law will turn out in full to support this event. At last year's event, we raised over £600 for the Charity and this year we would like to raise even more.
